

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-24

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK, AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO
PROVIDE UNIFORM FIRE CODE SERVICES TO THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN
PURSUANT TO THE INTERLOCAL SERVICES ACT**

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown has requested that the Borough of Red Bank provide Uniform Fire Code services to the Township of Middletown; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank Fire Marshal's Office will serve as the inter-local Local Enforcing Agency pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:71-2.3(a) et seq and said services shall include that of Fire Official, Fire Inspector(s), and Fire Investigator(s); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown shall compensate the Borough of Red Bank for said Uniform Fire Code Services in accordance with the agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is the sense of the governing body of the Borough of Red Bank that the proposed agreement under the Interlocal Services Act N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 is in the best interests of the two municipalities and will tend to promote economy and efficiency in government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank as follows:

Section 1. That the Borough Administrator is hereby authorized to negotiate an agreement to provide Uniform Fire Code Services to the Township of Middletown subject to approval by Resolution of the governing body of Red Bank.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication pursuant to law.
