Dear Dog or Cat Owner:

Red Bank Ordinances require that all Dogs and Cats seven (7) months of age or older be licensed. All licenses expire as of December 31 of the licensing year. *All dog or cat licenses renewed after February 28th of the licensing year will be charged an additional \$5.00 late fee..*

**PROOF OF RABIES VACCINATION MUST BE PRESENTED, AND BE VALID THROUGH OCTOBER OF LICENSING YEAR.**

**PLEASE NOTE:** The license fee is **\$18.00** for unneutered dogs or cats. If your animal has been neutered or spayed, the fee is **\$15.00**. Proof from the veterinarian is required.

Borough offices are currently closed to the public. This form can be returned by regular mail or by leaving it in the drop box in the Police Department in an envelope marked "Animal License." Once the renewal is processed, the updated tags will be mailed..

Violators of the Dog and Cat Ordinances will be issued a summons. A compendium of the Ordinances is on the back of this letter.

## DOG ORDINANCES

### CHAPTER 231

### ARTICLE I

### LICENSING AND REGULATION OF DOGS

231-1: No person owning or having the care, custody or control of any dog shall suffer or permit such dog to go or be off the premises owned by or in the possession of such person unless the dog shall be accompanied by a person who is capable to controlling such dog and who has the dog securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than six (6) feet long or in a crate or otherwise securely confined.

231-2: No person owning or having the care, custody or control of any dog shall permit such dog to soil or defile or to commit any nuisance upon any sidewalk, street or thoroughfare, in or upon any public property or in or upon the property of persons other than the owner or person having the care custody or control of such dog.

231-3: No person owning or having the care, custody or control of any dog shall suffer or permit it to soil or defile or do any injury or damage to any lawn, shrubbery, flowers, ground, trees or any property of persons other than the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such dog.

231-4: No person shall keep, harbor or maintain any dog which habitually barks or cries so as to disturb the public peace.

231-5: The owner or custodian of any dog shall be responsible for any damages done by said dog.

## CAT ORDINANCES

### CHAPTER 231

### ARTICLE II

### LICENSING AND REGULATION OF CATS

#### V231-21 Provisions relating to rabies vaccination of cats.

Vaccination and license requirements. No person shall own, keep, harbor or maintain any cat over seven months of age within the Borough of Red Bank, unless such cat is vaccinated and licensed.

## VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Any person violating any of the provision of the chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not to exceed TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) for the first conviction of such violation and upon failure to pay the said fine and the costs and charges incidental thereto, may be confined to the county jail for a period not to exceed ten (10) days; and in case of conviction for a second, subsequent or continuing violation, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) for each offense and upon failure to pay said fine and costs and charges incidental thereto may be confined to the county jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.
