**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT REQUEST TO  
THE NEW JERSEY FOREST SERVICE FOR  
A 2018 NJUCF STEWARDSHIP GRANT**

Councilman Yngstrom offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank, through and on behalf of its Shade Tree Committee, is seeking a grant in the amount of \$30,000.00 from the New Jersey Urban and Community Forestry Program (NJUCF) for a 2018 CSIP Grant to plant trees within the Borough pursuant to the Shade Tree Committee’s five-year Community Forestry Management Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, if this Grant is awarded, the Borough will only contribute in-kind services to be rendered by the Department of Public Works and members of, or recruited by, the Shade Tree Committee, the value of which in-kind services has been determined to be \$19,275 according to the Project Budget submitted by the Shade Tree Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, other than the in-kind services described above, the Borough will contribute no cash or funds as part of any municipal portion of this grant;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that it hereby approves the Shade Tree Committee’s submission of the above-described grant request in the amount of \$30,000.00; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Borough of Red Bank will further contribute in-kind services to be rendered by the Department of Public Works and volunteers belonging to, or recruited by, the Borough’s Shade Tree Committee, in accordance with the Project Budget submitted by the Shade Tree Committee, if this Grant is awarded.
