RESOLUTION NO. 18-209

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING APPROVAL OF SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE AND APPROPRIATION ACCORDING TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 – Clean Communities Fund, in the amount of \$21,388.61

Councilman Taylor offered the following resolution and moved its approval:

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for an equal amount; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2018 in the sum of \$21,388.61, under the title of Clean Communities Fund,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the like sum of \$21,388.61 is hereby appropriated under the caption of Clean Communities Fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above is the result of funds from the State of New Jersey through the State of New Jersey through the New Jersey Clean Communities Program in the amount of \$21,388.61.
