A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CURFEW FOR OCTOBER 30 AND 31, 2018

Councilman Whelan offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that a curfew be imposed on all person under the age of 18 years on October 30 and 31, 2018 between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. on all public streets, playgrounds, public buildings or places of business where the public is invited. This curfew will not apply to persons under the age of 18 years who are accompanied by their parent, guardian or other adult person having custody or control of them, are traveling from place of employment to their home, are traveling from a function sponsored by a religious, school, civic or other properly supervised event or program to their home, are traveling from a place at which a bonafide, supervised, social meeting, gathering or assemblage has taken place to their home.
