RESOLUTION TO ABOLISH POSITION OF MANAGER OF HUMAN RESOURCES

Councilman Taylor offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank previously contracted with Government Strategy Group to conduct a management audit of the Borough’s operations; and

WHEREAS, Government Strategy Group submitted a report (the “Report”) to the Borough in May of 2018 with the results of its management audit; and

WHEREAS, the Report recommends that a multi-pronged consolidation and reorganization of the Borough’s governmental services is warranted for reasons of efficiency and effectiveness, including, amongst other things, abolishing the position of Manager of Human Resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that, for reasons of efficiency and effectiveness, the Borough hereby abolishes the position of Manager of Human Resources effective October 31, 2018; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, hereby lays-off the incumbent from the position of Manager of Human Resources, effective midnight, October 31, 2018; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, hereby authorizes Borough personnel and/or legal counsel to take any actions necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.
