**A RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF A FULL-TIME
COMMUNICATIONS OFFICER (DISPATCHER)**

Councilman Zipprich offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank desires to fill a vacancy in the position of Communications Officer (Dispatcher); and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank has advertised the vacancy and received resumes that have been reviewed by the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended that it would be in the best interests of the Borough to appoint Attilio Aiello as Communications Officer (Dispatcher); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 90, Article VI, Section 90-28 of the Revised General Code of the Borough of Red Bank, the Business Administrator appoints Attilio Aiello as full-time Communications Officer (Dispatcher).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that they do hereby ratify and confirm the Business Administrator's appointment of Attilio Aiello as full-time Communications Officer (Dispatcher) effective December 13, 2018 at a rate of pay of \$17.35 per hour (Level 3), pending satisfactory completion of a criminal background investigation and subject to satisfactory completion of a probationary period of 90 days.
